Entry Requirements To Bally's Arapahoe Park

Thoroughbreds:

- 1. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued by an accredited veterinarian within 30 days of entry.
- 2. A negative Equine Infectious Anemia (Coggins Test) test within 12 months of entry. The name of the laboratory, results, date of the test, and accession number must be listed on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI).

Quarter Horses:

- 1. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued by an accredited veterinarian within 30 days of entry.
- 2. A negative Equine Infectious Anemia (Coggins Test) test within 12 months of entry. The name of the laboratory, results, date of the test, and accession number must be listed on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI).
- 3. A negative Equine Piroplasmosis test within 12 months of entry. The testing must include testing for both Theileria Equi and Babesia caballi.

Pony Horses:

- 1. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (VCI) issued by an accredited veterinarian within 30 days of entry.
- 2. A negative Equine Infectious Anemia (Coggins Test) test within 12 months of entry. The name of the laboratory, results, date of the test, and accession number must

be listed on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI).

* Any horses that leave Bally's Arapahoe Park and seek reentry must meet the entry requirements.

It is **recommended** that all horses are vaccinated for the following:

Core Vaccines:

- 1. Eastern and Western Equine Encephalomyelitis
 - within the last 6 months
- 2. Rabies
 - within the last 12 months
- 3. Tetanus
 - within the last 12 months
- 4. West Nile Virus
 - within the last 12 months

At Risk Vaccines:

- 5. Equine Herpes Virus Rhino (EHV-1 and EHV-4)
 - within the last 6 months
- 6. Equine Influenza (EIV)
 - within the last 6 months
