Ship in Requirements to Bally's Cheyenne Park

No horse will be allowed at a track and no horse shall be entered or permitted to start unless a current health certificate showing that the horse has been examined and found to be free from symptoms of any infectious disease is on file with the Racing Secretary.

The health certificate is valid when it is made by a licensed and accredited veterinarian in the state where the examination was made. It is current if it is within thirty (30) days prior (unless otherwise directed by the Wyoming State Veterinarian) to the date the horse arrives at a Wyoming race track for the first time in a calendar year. A horse shall not require a new health certificate when shipping directly from a Wyoming race track to another, if the certificate is dated within thirty (30) days of shipping. The certificate shall include the temperature of the horse at the time he is examined. The Permittee conducting the race meeting is responsible for compliance with this ruling.

A negative EIA (Coggins AGID or ELISA) test is required within twelve (12) months prior to arrival.

A negative Theileria equi (Piroplasmosis) cELISA test is required within twelve (12) months prior to arrival.

RULES and ELIGIBILITY

1. Stall Applications must be signed on the front and back to receive consideration.
2. Do NOT ship horses until you have been notified of stall allotment.
3. Any horse entered for racing must be present on the grounds at least 6 hours prior to the scheduled post time of the first race in which the horse is entered on any given calendar day.

Stall Application for Bally's Cheyenne Park

1. The statutes of the State of Wyoming, rules and regulations of the Wyoming Gaming Commission, and the Horsemen's Association recognized by Bally's Cheyenne Park (collectively "Rules") shall apply to the race meet to be conducted at the track, and Applicant agrees to be bound by them. In consideration of stalls allotted by Bally's Cheyenne Park to the Applicant, the Applicant accepts the conditions and policies of racing established by Bally's Cheyenne Park.

2. Bally's Cheyenne Park reserves the right to cancel or amend any race.

3. A registration certificate, relating to a horse, must be on file with the Racing Secretary before the entry of the horse is accepted, stakes races excluded.

4. Applicant shall be liable for its own acts and omissions, as well as those of its officers, agents, independent contractors, representatives and employees (together, "Representatives"). Applicant agrees to require its Representatives to strictly comply with the Rules. Applicant further agrees that it has sole responsibility for the safety and well being of its Representatives.

5. Bally's Cheyenne Park (BCP) reserves all rights to photographs, video tapes, television and motion pictures filmed or produced for non-income or noncommercial use. All entries will be accepted on the condition that if requested by BCP, the owner, trainer, groom, jockey and all other persons associated with the Applicant who may come into camera range, will sign a formal release permitting the taking of photographs, video tape, filming of such television or motion pictures, and the subsequent exhibition thereof.

6. In consideration of the allotment of stalls by BCP, hot and cold running water and electricity in stables and facilities located on the premises of BCP, the Applicant agrees to enter his/her horses when they are fit to run and suitable races are programmed. Applicant's horses will not be withheld as entries for any reason other than illness or inability to run for other valid causes. Applicant agrees to vacate the stalls allotted to him/her and to remove horses, equipment, and personnel from the premises of BCP within seventy-two (72) hours after being notified to do so.

7. The Applicant and all personnel under his/her control will refrain from smoking or using alcoholic beverages in the barn area. Possession of alcohol is prohibited in the barn area. The Applicant is responsible for the overall cleanliness of their assigned areas. The area shall extend from their assigned stalls to the roadway. This overall cleanliness includes, but is not limited to trash, weeds, and other debris.

The Applicant is responsible for any damage caused to the assigned area by the Applicant and its Representatives. No alterations may be made to the assigned area without prior approval by BCP.

8. This application, or its acceptance by BCP, shall not be construed as a lease of any particular space at BCP, but, upon acceptance of BCP, merely constitutes a revocable license or permit under the terms and conditions herein set forth. The signature of the Applicant on this Application is an acknowledgment that this applicant agrees to be subject to the terms and conditions hereof.

9. Bally's Cheyenne Park reserves the right to exclude any horse or horseman from participating in the 2026 meet for any reason including but not limited to: drug violations, qualifications, participating in programs, poor performance or any conduct not considered beneficial to the overall racing program at Bally's Cheyenne Park.

WAIVER AND INDEMNITY

The undersigned, in consideration of the allotment of stalls at Bally's Cheyenne Park, does hereby waive, release and forever hold harmless Bally's Wyoming, LLC, d/b/a Bally's Cheyenne Park, its officers, agents, representatives, employees, affiliates, and any others acting on behalf of Bally's Cheyenne Park (hereinafter the "Indemnified Parties"), from any and all liability for any loss, damage or destruction or injury to any person, horse or other personal property owned or leased by the Indemnified Parties, except to the extent the loss, damage, destruction or injury is caused solely by the negligence of any of the Indemnified Parties. The undersigned agrees to forever indemnify and reimburse the Indemnified Parties for any and all fees, expenses, costs or damages caused by the undersigned and its Representatives for any horse, person, property owned, leased or borrowed by the undersigned, while on the premises owned or leased by the Indemnified Parties.
