



ULTIMATE TEXAS HOLD'EM

ULTIMATE TEXAS HOLD'EM™ features heads-up play against the Dealer and an optional Bonus Bet. This game gives the Player several advantages:

- The earlier the Player bets, the more he can bet.
- The Player doesn't have to fold until seeing all the Community Cards.
- The optional Trips bonus pays odds if the Player's final five-card hand is a Three-of-a-Kind or Better

HOW TO PLAY

ANTE/BLIND	Each Player makes equal ANTE and BLIND bets to receive 2 cards
TRIPS BONUS	Players also have the option to place a BONUS TRIPS WAGER.
2-CARDS	A 2-card hand is dealt to each Player and the Dealer.
BEFORE FLOP	Players have the OPTION to check (not bet) or make a PLAY bet in an amount equal to 3x or 4x the ANTE.
3-CARDS	3 Community Cards are now dealt face-up on the table.
AFTER FLOP	Players who have <u>not</u> placed a prior PLAY bet have the OPTION to check (not bet) or make a bet in an amount equal to 2x the ANTE.
2-CARDS	2 Final Community Cards are now dealt face-up on the table.
ON THE RIVER	Players who have <u>not</u> placed a prior PLAY bet may fold or make a bet in an amount equal to 1x the ANTE.
FOLD	Players who decide to FOLD shall forfeit their ANTE and BLIND wagers.

The Dealer then reveals his two hole cards and announces his hand. If the Player's hand beats the Dealer's hand, the Player's PLAY and ANTE bets win even money. If the Dealer's hand beats the Player's hand, the Player's PLAY, ANTE and BLIND bets lose. All poker-ranked hands of equal value between Player and Dealer shall be considered a "Tie" or a "Push".

PAYOUT SCHEDULE

The payout for winning BLIND wagers is as follows:

Royal Flush	500 to 1*
Straight Flush	50 to 1*
Four-of-a-Kind (Quads)	10 to 1*
Full House	3 to 1*
Flush	3 to 2*
Straight	1 to 1*
Less than a Straight	Push*

***Blind wager shall not be paid unless the Player's hand ranks higher than the Dealer's hand. Ante pushes if Dealer has less than a Pair.**

OPTIONAL TRIPS BONUS WAGER

A Player who places an Ante and Blind wager may also place an optional Trips Bonus wager to win an additional payout that the Player's best five-card hand will be a Three-of-a-Kind or Better.

The payout for the Trip Bonus wager is as follows:

Royal Flush	50 to 1
Straight Flush	40 to 1
Four-of-a-Kind (Quads)	30 to 1
Full House	8 to 1
Flush	6 to 1
Straight	5 to 1
Three-of-a-Kind (Trips)	3 to 1

\$50,000 Maximum Aggregate Payout Limit On All Winning ANTE, PLAY, BLIND and TRIPS wagers for any hand.

ADDITIONAL RULES OF PLAY

Player must make equal bets on the Ante and Blind.

Only Players who are seated at the table may place a wager at the game.

Once a Player has placed a wager and received cards, that Player must remain seated until the completion of the round of play.

Players shall not be permitted to wager on more than one player position.

A winning Trips wager shall be paid without regard to the outcome of any other wager made by the Player.
