



Unlike traditional Poker, High Card Flush is “suits based” card game played with a standard 52-card deck featuring two (2) optional BONUS bets: Flush and Straight Flush. The object of the game is to get a better Flush hand than the Dealer. **BEST FLUSH WINS!**

### Ranking of Hands

Ace, King, Queen, Jack, Ten, Nine, Eight, Seven, Six, Five, Four, Three and Two. Ace may be used to complete a “Straight Flush” with a Two and Three, and in addition to the Two and Three, in regard to a larger “Straight Flush,” a Four, Five, Six and/or Seven.

### The Play

Each Player receives seven (7) cards and competes against the Dealer’s seven (7) cards.

**Ante:** Each Player must place an Ante wager prior to the Dealer announcing “No more bets.”.

**Bonus:** Players also have the option to place an optional “Flush Bonus” wager and/or an optional “Straight Flush Bonus” wager.

**Fold or Raise:** After the cards are dealt, Player can either: (1) Fold (forfeit) his/her Ante wager; or (2) Make a Raise wager. If a Player made an optional Bonus wager(s) and chooses to fold, the Player will lose his/her Ante wager, but will not lose his/her Bonus wager(s). Continue playing by placing a Raise wager. A Player who makes an Ante wager and a Raise wager will be eligible for an even money payout.

### Winning and Losing

Winning hands are based upon the number of cards of the same suit (“Flush”) in the Player’s or Dealer’s hand.

The Dealer then reveals his cards. Dealer must have a 9 High Three Card Flush for Player Raise bets to qualify against hand.

If the Player’s hand beats the Dealer’s hand, the Ante and Raise wagers WIN and are paid at even money. If the Dealer’s hand beats the Player’s hand, the Ante and Raise wagers lose. **If the Player’s hand and the Dealer’s hand tie, the Ante and Raise wagers push.**

### Raise Wager

A Player can Raise his/her Ante bet up to 3X the Ante, depending on how many cards are suited.



Two, Three or Four suited cards – Raise 1x  
Five suited cards – Raise 2x  
Six or Seven suited cards – Raise 3x

### Flush Bonus Wager Payout

Each Player may place an optional Flush Bonus wager. Player WINS when his/her hand matches one of the hands on the pay table below.



HAND	PAYS
7 Card Flush	300 to 1
6 Card Flush	100 to 1
5 Card Flush	10 to 1
4 Card Flush	1 to 1

### Straight Flush Bonus Wager Payout

Each Player may place an optional Straight Flush Bonus wager. Player WINS when his/her hand matches one of the hands on the pay table below.



HAND	PAYS
7 Card Straight Flush	8000 to 1
6 Card Straight Flush	1000 to 1
5 Card Straight Flush	100 to 1
4 Card Straight Flush	60 to 1
3 Card Straight Flush	7 to 1

ONLY THE HIGHEST QUALIFYING HAND IS PAID.

**MAXIMUM AGGREGATE BONUS PAYOUT  
OF \$50,000 PER ROUND**

### Additional Rules

- Flush Bonus and Straight Bonus wagers are independent of each other. Player may win both bets, if he/she has a hand that qualifies for both.
- Player may wager only one hand.
- Only Players who are seated may wager and cards must remain on top of the layout.
- No showing or discussing of hands between Players.
