







### Bally's Casino at Medinah Temple - Operational Overview

#### Patron experience thoughtfully curated to provide top-notch experience

- Historical aspects of the Medinah Temple to remain untouched
- Three floors of unique gaming experience including over 800 slot machines and 50 table games
  - Examples include blackjack, roulette, craps, and baccarat
- Showcase center bar, 3-meal restaurant, and alternative quick serve food venues
- Variety of local food and beverage offerings to highlight Chicago's best









### Best-In-Class Operational Safety Initiatives

#### Bally's will continue to collaborate with our community partners to provide a safe environment

#### **Entering the Casino**

- Single casino entrance check point vital to guest safety
- Mandatory identification check for all guests at entry point
- Mask down policy for identification validation and surveillance capture upon entry

### Camera Monitoring Technology

- State-of-the art 24/7 gaming surveillance system with video retention
- Concealed weapons detection technology with added onboard cameras for close-up image capture
- Controlled / badged access to back-of-house areas

# Exterior Security Measures

- High-tech video coverage around the casino security zone
- Daily management of pedestrian and vehicular traffic in coordination with OEMC
- Establish perimeter security posts on Wabash/State/Ohio/Ontario in conjunction with CPD assigned resources
- Increased coverage during peak volume and city/community wide event dates
- Private security roving / mobile patrol and communication with local law enforcement

#### \$200k annual commitment to responsible gaming programs

### Promoting responsible gaming is our culture

- Enforcement set forth by Illinois Gaming Board
- IGB Statewide Voluntary Self-Exclusion Program
- Required annual employee training

- Permit Review Committee (PRC) approval obtained for exterior signage and interior landmarked elements






