



■ Cost: \$1.7+ billion



PD 1426 w/ Bally's Chicago







River Walk: Active + Passive Recreation

2,100 Feet of Contiguous River Walk, Public Parks, Docks, Water Taxi, Restaurants + Amenities













Transportation Analysis: Peak Hours vs. Planned PD










Friday Evening Peak

Off Site: Suggested Improvements

City Improvements:

- A. Chicago Avenue Bridge reconstruction and widening, 2023
- B. Chicago Avenue and Halsted Street Viaduct reconstruction, 2023
- C. Division Street Bridge East reconstruction and widening, 2023
- D. Division Street Bridge West reconstruction and widening, 2023
- E. Regional transitway, long range project


